

PROJECT SPOTLIGHT | REGIONAL COLLECTION CENTER (RCC) - WAYNE-RINGGOLD-DECATUR SANITARY LANDFILL - GRAND RIVER, IOWA

SCOPE OF PROJECT

BARKER LEMAR was retained by the Wayne-Ringgold-Decatur Solid Waste Commission to develop and submit a regional collection center (RCC) establishment grant. Grant funds would be used to construct and operate a RCC to service the entire planning area. If awarded, **BARKER LEMAR** would be responsible for RCC building design, survey, construction bid letting activities, household hazardous materials (HHM) operation plans, HHM education, and general permit requirements. **BARKER LEMAR** would also assist the commission with fulfilling the reporting requirements of the grant.



IMPLEMENTATION

BARKER LEMAR submitted the RCC establishment grant and received \$96,000. **BARKER LEMAR** worked closely with the commission to design a RCC that would service both the existing and future integrated solid waste management needs of the Commission. The RCC's operation plans, comprehensive educational programs, and permit requirements have been developed and are ready for implementation when construction starts on the facility.
