

# PROJECT SPOTLIGHT | ASSESSMENT INVENTORY UPDATE - ST. LOUIS-JEFFERSON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT - ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI



## SCOPE OF PROJECT

The St. Louis-Jefferson Solid Waste Management District (SWMD) retained the services of BARKER LEMAR to perform activities necessary to update their assessment inventory. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) requires each SWMD to update and submit an assessment inventory every two years.

## IMPLEMENTATION

BARKER LEMAR met with SWMD staff to identify project objectives and also met with MDNR officials to confirm requirements to be completed in order to develop a successful assessment inventory update.

BARKER LEMAR met with communities identified by the SWMD to interview officials in order to update their assessment inventory information. Phone interviews and mailed surveys were conducted for the remaining communities to receive the necessary information. Through these efforts, BARKER LEMAR received responses from more than 120 communities.

BARKER LEMAR also met with commercial waste haulers and recycling service providers to receive information concerning their services within the SWMD.

BARKER LEMAR compiled the survey results and developed an assessment inventory update. The data was presented in a hard copy report, as well as in an electronic database format, so the SWMD could utilize the data in other reports and service tracking programs.
