



SCOPE OF PROJECT

In an effort to assist solid waste planning areas in Iowa with developing efficient and safe solid waste management systems, BARKER LEMAR researched and designed a seven-hour transfer station operator training course. The course is designed to help operators understand the regulatory requirements involved in operating a transfer station in Iowa, as well as aiding to improve service at their facilities.

IMPLEMENTATION

BARKER LEMAR'S transfer station operator training course educates students on a variety of topics, including transfer station design, transfer station operational requirements, state and federal rules and regulations, waste screening, and emergency response and preparedness. BARKER LEMAR staff offers the training course several times per year and has packaged the course materials for sale to entities wishing to implement their own training program.
